



Nordic Sea Hotel – Swan certified



Nordic Sea Hotel takes its environmental responsibility seriously. We want to play an active role in making our society greener. We know that our guests also want to contribute to this development. That is why care for the environment forms a natural aspect of our work and the hotel carries the 'Swan' environmental marking. When our guests choose us they contribute to a better environment for society as a whole. The Swan is a Nordic certification system that seeks to make it easier for consumers and commercial buyers to choose goods and services with the lowest possible environmental impact. Environmental labelling stimulates the business sector and manufacturers to develop more environmentally friendly goods and services. The criteria for Swan certification are based on a life-cycle perspective, where the overall environmental impact of a service or product is assessed. The Swan makes it easy for you to contribute to a sustainable future, so that coming generations will continue to be able to travel as we do today. The future is in the making – right now.

The following areas are examples of where Nordic Sea Hotel works from a sustainability perspective:

- A high percentage of our heating comes from renewable energy sources.
- An increasing proportion of our electricity comes from renewable sources.
- At least 90 % (measured in production costs) of the hotel's printed materials are environmentally certified.
- Battery recycling service available for guests.
- External lighting is only used according to time or need.
- Energy analyses are carried out in order to reduce energy usage.
- Environmentally certified cleaning products are used.
- Hazardous and bulky waste produced at the hotel is categorised and dealt with in an environmentally sound manner, according to the advice of the authorities.
- Our goal is for at least 40 % (measured in weight) of our bed linen and towels to be certified with the Swan or the EU flower.
- Our goal is for more than 90 % of our toilets to use no more than 6 litres of water per flush.
- Reactive compounds (such as chlorine) may not be used.
- The hotel does not serve drinks in disposable cups or glasses.
- Use of low energy light bulbs.
- When interiors are being created or renovated, floors, wallpaper and skirting boards may not contain halogenated plastics.
- 2 flush options on at least 50% of our toilets.
- 70 % of washing-up liquids and drying agents (based on the active ingredient) must be environmentally certified.
- 90 % of the volume of soft paper purchased (including kitchen roll, paper towels and toilet roll) must be environmentally certified.
